Proposed **amendment # (1)** to the sub-recipient contract between the City of Baton Rouge, Parish of East Baton Rouge and **Our Lady of the Lake Hospital, Inc.** increasing the amount of compensation from \$110,000.00 by \$249,684.00 for a new sum not to exceed \$359,684.00 to provide additional Ryan White White/EHE funding for services and administrative fees, and to extend the contract period to February 29, 2024. **(By: DHDS/Ryan White)**

Department of Treasury amending the term from September 30, 2022 to September 30, 2023 with an increase in the ERA-2 allocation by \$25,000.00 for a new total not to exceed \$353,185.00. **(By: DHDS)**
