Proposed professional services agreement between the City of Baton Rouge, Parish of East Baton Rouge, on behalf of the Mayor’s Office of Community Development and Business Systems and Consultants, Inc. to provide document scanning conversion services in a sum not to exceed \$50,000.00 for the term commencing June 1, 2022 and terminating June 31, 2023. **(By: Community Development)**
2. Proposed amendment # (1) to the professional services agreement between the City of Baton Rouge, Parish of East Baton Rouge, on behalf of the Mayor’s Office of Community Development and The Lost Power, LLC d/b/a Shanderrick Williams amending the original contract amount of \$42,000.00 with an additional allocation of \$21,500.00 for a new total sum not to exceed \$63,500.00 for the term commencing January 1, 2022 and terminating December 31, 2022. **(By: Community Development)**
