X. Hearings

A. Approved. Citation #4637 issued to Fun and Food LLC d/b/b Revel 41, 4530 S. Sherwood Forest Blvd., for violation of the Wine, Beer & Liquor Ordinance, Section 9:1013 (6) – Operating without a permit. The alleged violation occurred on May 10, 2022. Agent Henderson gave a brief description of the incident prior to the citation being issued. Motioned by Mr. Shelton and seconded by Mr. Lascaro to find the violation did occur, to assess the statutory fine of \$750.00 and to suspend the license until paid. Hearing no objections, the motion passed.

B. Approved. Citation #4647 issued to 300 Lee Drive LLC d/b/a Store 161, 300 Lee Drive, for violation of the Wine, Beer & Liquor Ordinance, Section 9:1017 (B)(2) – Sales of alcoholic beverages to persons 18, 19 or 20 years of age; and Section 9:1013 (4) – Allowing unlicensed persons to perform services.
