- A. Approved. Citation #4709** issued to **MMCS Services LLC d/b/a MMCS Services Store #556**, 10221 Coursey Blvd., for violation of the Wine, Beer & Liquor Ordinance, **Section 9:1000(A)** – License required. The alleged violation occurred on August 3, 2022. Agent Graham gave a brief description of the incident prior to the citation being issued. Motioned by Mr. Shelton and seconded by Mr. Facey to assess the fine of \$300.00 and to suspend the license until paid. Hearing no objections, the motion passed.

- B. Approved. Citation #4705** issued to **Race Trac Petroleum Inc. d/b/a Race Trac #248**, 10738 Old Hammond Hwy., for violation of the Wine, Beer & Liquor Ordinance, **Section 9:1000(A)** – License required (4 Counts). The alleged violation occurred on July 26, 2022. Agent Graham gave a brief description of the incident prior to the citation being issued. Motioned by Mr. Tettleton and seconded by Mr. Krause to find the violation did occur and to assess the statutory fine of \$1,200 and suspend the license until paid. Hearing no objections, the motion passed.

Citation #4728 issued to **One Stop Deli & Grocery LLC d/b/a One Stop Deli & Grocery**, 191 Wooddale Blvd., for violation of the Wine, Beer & Liquor Ordinance, **Section 9:1017(2)** – Sales of alcoholic beverages to persons 18, 19 or 20 years of age. The alleged violation occurred on July 26, 2022. Motioned by Mr. Tettleton and seconded by Mr. Shelton to recognize the payment as admission of guilt. Hearing no objections, the motion passed.
