ROBBERY SUSPECT WANTED

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are searching for the individual in the attached photographs who is responsible for robbing Lee Michaels Fine Jewelry, 6401 Bluebonnet Boulevard, today around 4:00pm.

The suspect entered the business posing as a customer and requested a piece of jewelry from the display case. The suspect then grabbed the jewelry and fled the area in a dark gray compact vehicle.

The suspect is described as a slim build white male with long dark curly hair, facial hair, 25-32 years of age, 6'-6"2" wearing a black shirt with green sweat pants. The suspect also has a facial tattoo along with tattoos on his right arm.

There were no reported injuries.
