BRPD OFFICER INVESTIGATION

The Baton Rouge Police Department conducted two separate internal investigations that resulted in the termination of one officer and the arrest of another.

The Baton Rouge Police Internal Affairs Division concluded an administrative investigation involving Officer Siya Creel. The Internal Affairs Investigation revealed that Ofc. Creel willfully engaged in the adverse conduct when he failed to comply with policy, procedures and Departmental regulations. Ofc. Creel was terminated today for violating BRPD Policies. Ofc. Creel is a 5 year veteran who was currently assigned to the Uniform Patrol Division.

In a separate investigation, Baton Rouge Police Detectives arrested Corporal Jeremiah Ardoin for his alleged involvement in the purchase and receiving of stolen property. On December 9, 2020 Cpl. Jeremiah Ardoin was charged with Criminal Conspiracy and Illegal Possession of Stolen Things.

Cpl. Ardoin is a 12 year veteran who is currently assigned to the Criminal Investigative Bureau. He has been placed on Administrative Leave pending an Internal Affairs administrative investigation.
