- ✗ Power tools
- ✗ Styrofoam including peanuts
- ✗ Construction/demolition debris
- ✗ School lab waste
- ✗ Appliances
- ✗ Furniture
- ✗ Any liquid in containers larger than 5 gallons
- ✗ Medical waste/all medicines
