This event will be held at the District 6 Metro Council Office, located at 9048 Airline Highway, Baton Rouge, LA 70816 (across the parking lot from Baton Rouge Police Headquarters), 4 p.m.–7 p.m. Saturday, August 28, 2021.

The Baton Rouge Parade of Champions event is the kickoff of a four-city parade tour for cancer awareness. After the Baton Rouge parade on August 28, 2021, next up is the Mobile, AL, parade on September 18, 2021; the Houston/Humble, TX, parade, which also features a golf tournament, on October 9, 2021; and finally the Waveland, MS, parade on October 23, 2021.
