## **ARREST MADE IN N.13<sup>th</sup> STREET HOMICIDE**

Update 09-09-2021

Today, Baton Rouge Police Detectives with the assistance of the U.S. Marshals Task Force arrested CHRISTOPHER BACON, 44 of 5959 W. Sam Houston, Houston, Texas. Investigators believe that BACON is connected in the death of LARRY WINFREY, along with the injuring of two other individuals that occurred on July 28, 2021.

BACON was booked in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on the charges of First Degree Murder and Attempted First Degree Murder (2 counts).

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating a shooting that occurred yesterday around 6:30 p.m. at 125 N. 13<sup>th</sup> Street.

Investigators believe that LARRY WINFREY, 33 of 133 Julia Street, along with two other male victims, 48-year old and 76-year old, were gathered around the front porch when shots were fired from a passing vehicle.

WINFREY succumbed to his injuries at the scene. The two other victims were transported to a local hospital with reported non-life-threatening injuries.
