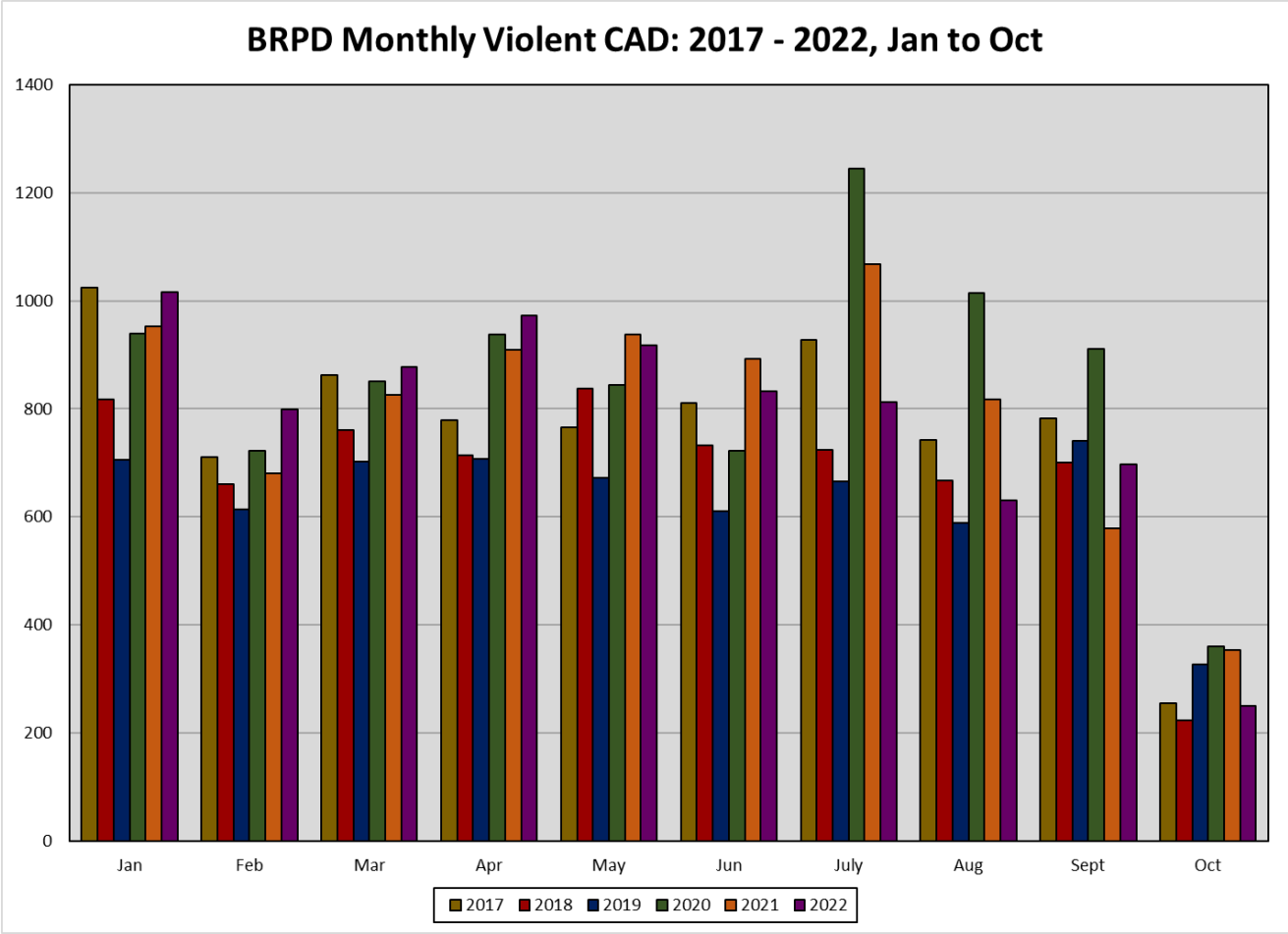

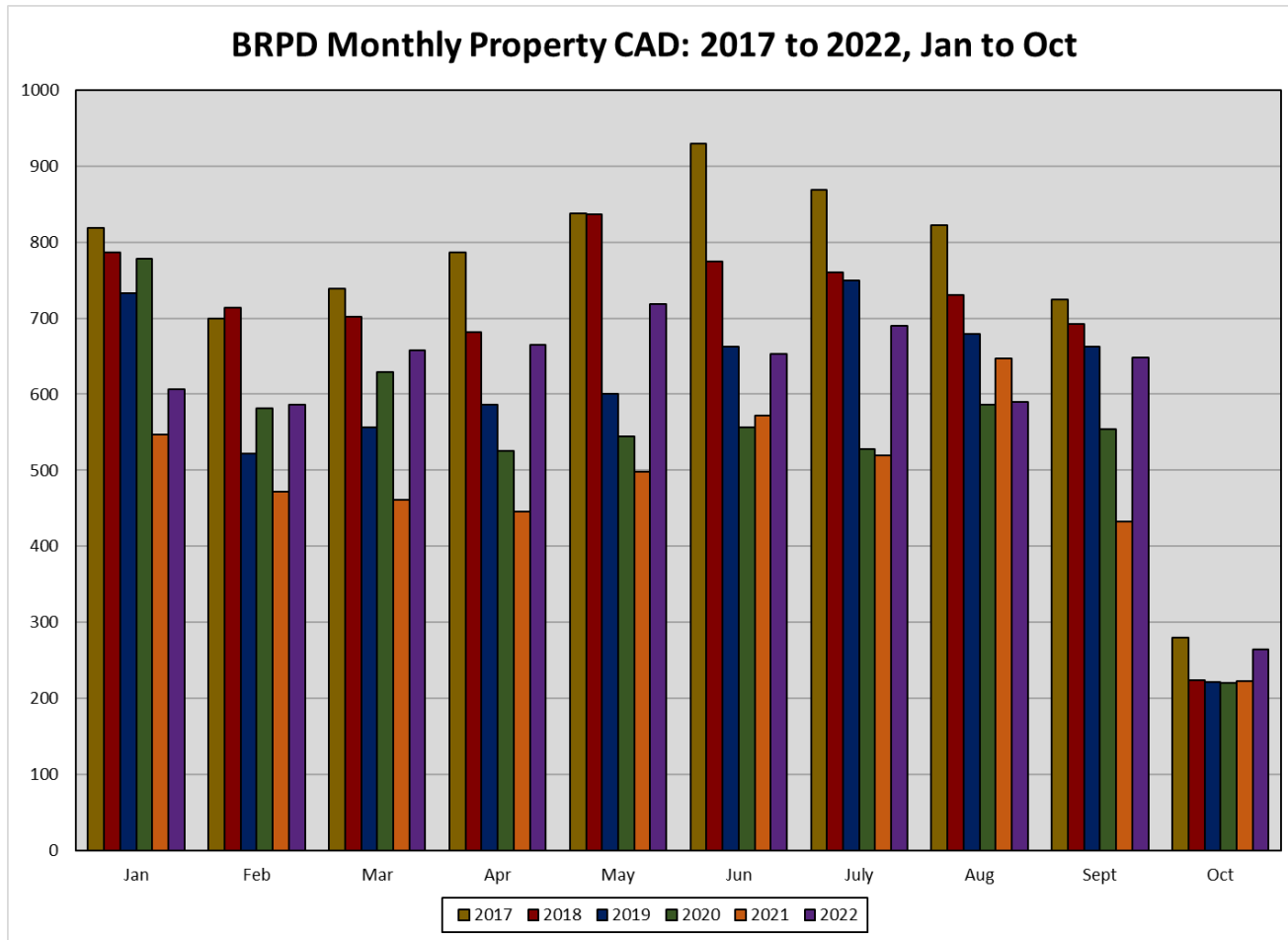

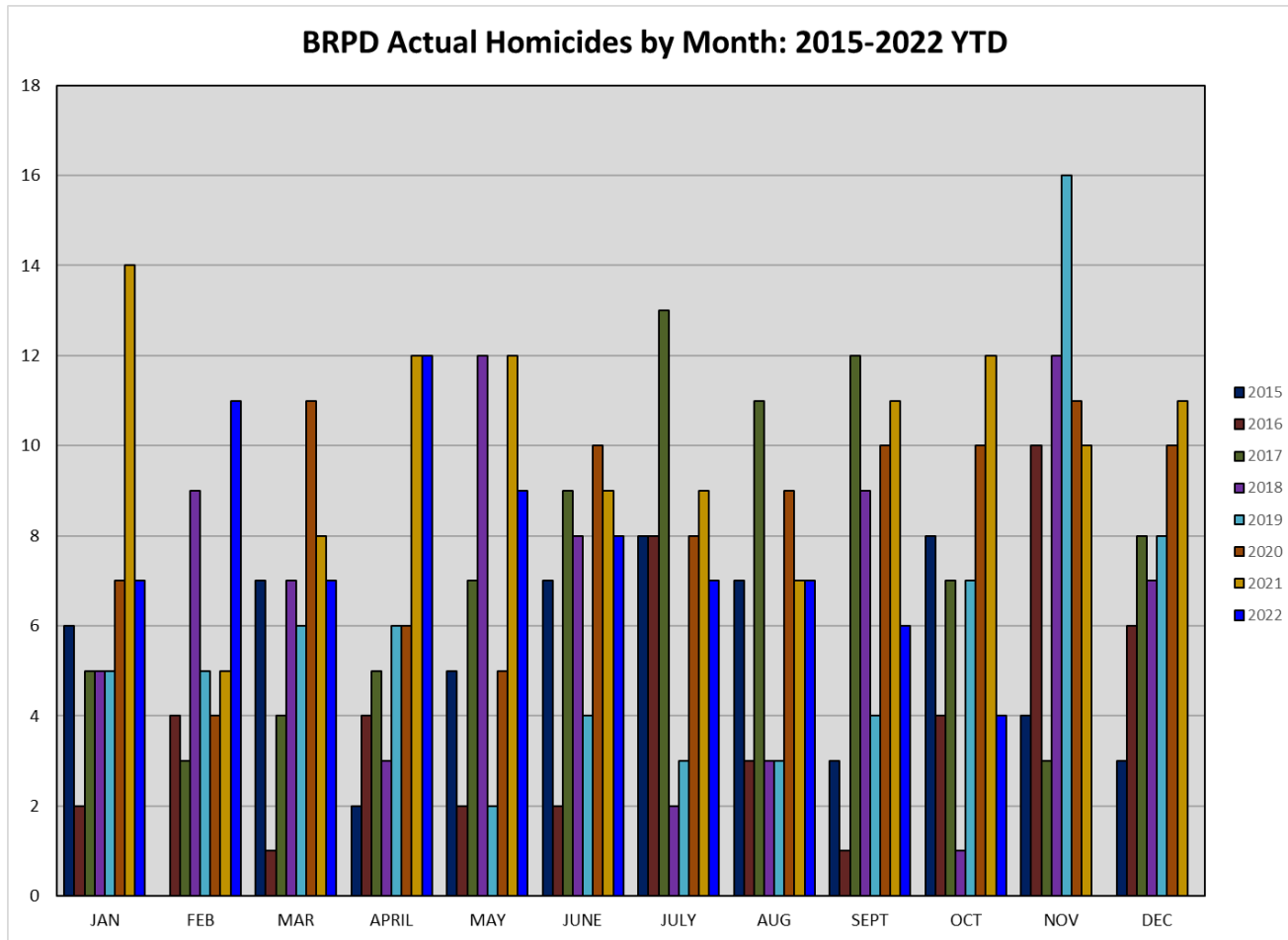

Arrests and Misc

Total Arrests

- As of 10/17/22, there have been 3373 felony arrests and 396 juvenile arrests.

Evidence – Firearm Totals

2021

- There were 1536 guns seized by BRPD in 2021. 1160 of those collected as evidence and 376 collected as found/personal property. Of the 1536 guns seized, 213 were stolen recovered. Total number of stolen guns reported was 615, averaging 50 monthly.

2022 Mid-Year

- As of 10/17/22, there has been a total of 1518 firearms collected by BRPD. Of those 1518, 1184 were seized as evidence and 334 were collected as found/personal property. Of the 334 that were collected, 195 were stolen recovered. Total number of stolen guns reported was 288, averaging 48 monthly (as of 7/12/22).

Summary and Comments

- *CAD overall has declined since 2016. In 2016, there were 222,011 total calls, which decreased to 217,360 calls in 2017 (-2.1%). In 2018, BRPD had 203,869 total CAD calls, which is an 8.17% decrease from 2016. The CAD calls dropped to 202,437 in 2019, which is 0.7% down from 2018. Note – New CAD went live October 1, 2019. There was an increase in CAD calls for 2020 (203,894, +0.7%). In 2021, calls continued to increase to 204,492 (+0.29%). As of mid October 2022, BRPD is on track to decrease CAD calls when compared to 2021 (151,286 calls currently) (*potential new CAD system data issues end of 2019 and into 2020)*
- *When comparing 2022 to 2021, as of mid October, Property CAD has increased by 26.19% (mainly with a large increase in Motor Vehicle Theft, +39.52%, and Vehicle Burglary, +44.19%). Violent CAD has decreased overall, as of mid October, by 5.50%. When looking at Property CAD, every category is up. When looking at Violent CAD, there was a decrease in bomb threat calls (-66.67%), as well as, shots fired/shooting (-13.10%) and stabbing calls (-26.09%).*
- *As of October 11, 2022, actual homicide counts were down by 12.36% when comparing to 2021 and down 12.24% when looking at total homicide counts.*
