UPDATE-SHOOTING ON NORTH BLVD

Update

The shooting victim, CURTIS TRUSCLAIR, 31 has died from his gunshot injuries. Darrel Jupiter's arrest charge will be upgraded to 2nd Degree Murder.

Baton Rouge Police Uniformed Officers arrested DARREL JUPITER, 46 for his involvement in a shooting of a 31 year old male victim that occurred in the 4200 block of North Blvd around 3:41pm yesterday afternoon.

The 31 year old male victim was called to a crash scene by one of the involved vehicle drivers. Jupiter, the other driver of the vehicle that was involved in the crash, became upset and began shooting at the 31 old year old victim striking him multiple times.

Responding Officers were able to apprehend Jupiter after a brief foot pursuit. The victim was transported to a local hospital and is expected to survive his injuries.

Jupiter was booked into East Baton Rouge Parish Prison for Attempt 1st Degree Murder, Convicted Felon with a Firearm and Illegal Use of Weapon.
