SUSPECT ARRESTED FOR NATHAN MILLARD'S DISAPPEARANCE

Update

Baton Rouge Police Detectives arrested Derrick Perkins, 45, today for his involvement in the improper disposing of Nathan Millard's body.

Perkins was in East Baton Rouge Parish Prison relative to an Access Device Fraud charge prior to this arrest.

Perkins has now been charged with Unlawful Disposal of Remains, Obstruction of Justice, Simple Criminal Damage to Property and Failure to Seek Assistance.

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are attempting to locate DERRICK PERKINS, 45 for Probation Violation, Criminal Damage to Property, 3 counts of Access Device Fraud, and Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle.

Perkins is also needed for questioning in the Nathan Millard missing person case investigation that began on February 23, 2023. Perkins was last seen in the South Baton Rouge area driving a 2003 Toyota Camry.
