Baton Rouge, LA — In our efforts to transition District 5 to reach its full potential, we are hosting a public meeting for around 6,000 residents that will put the power of improvement into their hands. These Crime Prevention & Improvement Districts will yield money that will allow the community to control the resources for revitalization through crime prevention, beautification, and youth programming. The Glen Oaks Area Crime Prevention District will have an estimate \$439,800 annually, and the Victoria Farms Crime Prevention & Improvement District will have an estimated \$114,900 annually if voted into law by residents this fall. This meeting will allow the community to give feedback on how to get the message out, what they would like to see from this initiative, and will provide an opportunity for each resident get involved.
