The Atlantic Hurricane Season begins on June 1st and lasts through November 30th. It's important to plan ahead to ensure safety during an emergency. Use these tips to get Red Stick Ready for Hurricanes!

BEFORE A HURRICANE:

- Create a family emergency communication plan to include important phone numbers.
- Build a disaster supply kit to include but not limited to a flashlight, batteries, cash, first aid kit, medications, and your important documents.
- Don't forget about supplies for your pets!
- Fuel your vehicles, generators, and gas cans.
- Trim or remove damaged trees and limbs around your home.
- Secure loose rain gutters and downspouts and clear any clogged areas or debris to lessen water damage to your property.
- Reduce property damage by retrofitting to secure and reinforce your roof, windows and doors, including the garage doors.

DURING A HURRICANE:

- Know the difference between a
 Hurricane Watch and Warning Hurricane Watch means conditions
 possible within the next 48 hours.
 Hurricane Warning means
 conditions are expected within 36 hours.
- Use the BuddySystem[™] to check on your neighbors, friends, and family.
- Listen to local officials for updates and instructions.
- Stay informed with real time information by:
 - Monitoring your local weather radio and TV stations.

 - Download the free Red Stick Ready app on your smartphone.

AFTER A HURRICANE:

- Check-in with family and friends.
- Return home only when authorities indicate it is safe.
- Report utility outages to your provider.
- Stay away from downed trees and power lines.
- Document damages and notify your insurance provider.
- Avoid walking or driving through flood waters.
- Practice electrical safety and proper ventilation when using extension cords and portable generators.
