SHOOTING INVESTIGATION

<u>Update</u>

Baton Rouge Police Detectives have issued an arrest warrant for RICHARD TERRELL DAVIS, 18, 3044 ELGIN ST, for his involvement in the shooting that occurred on May 17, 2018 at 3730 Winbourne Ave around 8:40pm

Davis is wanted for Attempt 1st Degree Murder, Attempt 2nd Degree Feticide and Aggravated Criminal Damage to Property. Anyone having information on Davis whereabouts is urged to contact the Violent Crimes Unit at 389-4869 or Crime Stoppers at 344-7867.

Baton Rouge Police arrested Nortrell Poole, 19, 3888 Juban Ave for his involvement in a shooting that occurred at 3730 Winbourne Ave last night around 8:40pm. Police learned that two groups of individuals had an argument after a football scrimmage at Istrouma High. During the argument at least two guys pulled handguns and began shooting at members in each group.

A 32 year old pregnant female bystander was struck in the midsection by gunfire. She was transported to a local hospital and is expected to survive her injury. The unborn fetus injury is unknown at this time.

Poole was booked into East Baton Rouge Parish for Attempt 2nd Degree Murder, Attempt 2nd Degree Feticide and Aggravated Criminal.
