UPDATE TO 17th ST. SHOOTING

Update 05-21-18

DEANDRE HOLLINS was taken into custody today after turning himself in. HOLLINS will be booked in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on charges of 2nd Degree Murder, Attempted 2nd Degree Murder, Illegal Use of a Weapon and Aggravated Assault.

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating a shooting that occurred last night around 8:30pm in the 500 block of 17th Street.

KELVIN HOWARD, 41 of 1967 North Street was pronounced dead at the scene. A second victim, 32-year-old male, was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Investigators believe that DEANDRE HOLLINS is responsible for the shootings that occurred following an altercation.

HOLLINS is wanted on charges of 2nd Degree Murder, Attempted 2nd Degree Murder, Illegal Use of a Weapon and Aggravated Assault.
