

# Baton Rouge FREE Clinic

## CALL FOR PATIENTS

A **FREE** two-day dental, medical and vision clinic is coming to North Baton Rouge on Friday, March 15<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019, at the Multiplex Building at the Baton Rouge Airport located on Airpark Blvd., near the Baton Rouge Airport. Clinic hours will be 7:00 a.m.–7:00 p.m.

The Clinic will provide at no cost to the patient: eye exams with prescription and glasses; dental fillings, cleaning and extractions; diabetes and blood pressure screenings; flu shots; free haircuts; lifestyle counseling; and community resources will be offered as well.

All services are free of charge and no pre-qualifications required. Patients will be cared for on a first come, first served basis. (Capacity is limited so you will want to arrive early with a snack and water.) The day may be long, so we ask for your patience and cooperation. Please continue to take all medications prescribed by your doctor and bring all medications to the clinic with you. Appointments cannot be made in advance. We do not require proof of insurance, employment, income, ID or immigration status. Everyone can receive services.
