

Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) Map - CHECKLIST Requirements

Please submit a one-page, **8½ x 11 simple plot plan** of the construction site. A hand drawn plot plan is preferred, more than an architectural, finely detailed, map. Use the following CHECKLIST to complete an acceptable ESC Map. If an item is not applicable for the project, list that item with a reason in a statement.

1. Write the following on the Map

- “NOT TO SCALE” at the top of the map;
- The City Parish PERMIT NUMBER;
- The Project’s Physical Address, including Zip Code, and Lot Number;
- The Contractor or Builder’s name, email address, and best contact phone number;
- The name of the Subdivision or Business; and
- The contractor must sign and date the map.**

2. Write and Show the approximate locations of these sediment control measures on the Map:

- The stabilized entrances/exits,
- Proposed perimeter controls such as silt fencing, existing vegetation, grass mesh, and/or wattles, etc.,
- The above-ground concrete and paint wash areas,
- The trash dumpster (keep debris inside the container; and
- The location of the portable toilet (Never place a toilet over the nearest stormdrain. Document all toilet spills and remediate the spill within 24 hours).

3. Also, Write and Show each of the following on the Map:

- Use geographic compass arrows (**North, South, East, and West**) at the front entrance,
- Use directional arrows to show the flow of residual runoff after a rain event,
- Any stormdrains within 50 feet of the site entrance;
- Any permanent waterbody [ditch, creek, pond] within 50 feet of the lot,
- Any natural features that will remain on-site [trees, brush, etc.], and
- The material storage area [lumber, paints, sheetrock, tools, etc.].
