MURDER ARREST

Update

Joshua Johnson, 25, 906 North 37th St was apprehended today by Louisiana State Police Task Force for the fatal shooting of Johnny Warren, 31. The shooting occurred on June 18, 2018 around 1:40am in the 1200 block of South 15th Street.

Police believe an ongoing dispute may have been the cause for the shooting.

Johnson was booked into East Baton Rouge Parish Prison for 1st Degree Murder and Attempt 1st Degree Murder (1ct).

Original-June 18, 2018

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating a fatal shooting that occurred this morning around 1:40am in the 1200 block of S.15th Street.

JOHNNY WARREN, 31 of 1440 S.17th Street died on scene from apparent gunshot injuries. A second victim, 30-year-old male, also sustained apparent gunshot injuries and later arrived at a local hospital and is expected to survive.

Investigators believe that the two victims were inside a vehicle when the suspect(s) began firing into the vehicle.

There are no known motives or suspects at this time.
