Multiple iterations of severe weather, including flash flooding, heavy rain, and tornadic activity swept through the State of Louisiana June 5 – 6, 2019. Requests for Individual Assistance (IA) Preliminary Damage Assessments (PDA) were received through WebEOC on June 10th, June 17th and June 19th, 2019. GOHSEP completed all IA PDAs for the requesting parishes by Friday, June 28th. Please see below for a summary of the completed IA PDAs for this event:
