Investigation Results:

Sustained -The investigation showed that the officer did violate policy and corrective actions will be implemented in accordance with established departmental procedures.

Not Sustained - There was insufficient evidence to either sustain the complaint or exonerate the officer.

Pending - A complaint that occurred near the end of the calendar year and there had not been a formal determination of the investigation results by the Chief of Police as of the date the statistics were published.

Investigation Terminated - A complaint that has been terminated because the complainant no longer wished for the complaint to go forward.

Exonerated - The Chief of Police has reviewed the investigation results and determined that there is sufficient evidence to prove the officer acted properly and the complainant's allegations are totally false.
