ARREST MADE IN BLVD DE PROVINCE SHOOTING

Update 04-01-2020

Today, Baton Rouge Police Detectives arrested TYLER TURNER, 20 of 2001 S. Sherwood Forest Blvd. Investigators believe that TURNER is connected in the shooting death of MARQUIS McCOY that occurred on November 24, 2019.

TURNER was booked in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on the charge of First Degree Murder.

Update 11-26-19

The victim in this incident has been identified as MARQUIS McCOY, 34 of 1262 Aster Street.

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating a fatal shooting that occurred in the 1800 block of Blvd De Province around 6:02pm yesterday evening. An unidentified black man was shot and transported to a local hospital where he later succumbed to his injuries.

The shooting victim has not been identified at this time.

The motive and suspect are unknown.
