HIT AND RUN CRASH ON NORTH ARDENWOOD

A 17 year old man was arrested this morning for a traffic crash that involved a pedestrian. The crash occurred around 3:20am this morning in the 1200 block of North Ardenwood Dr. The 17 year old was driving a 2008 Toyota Camry south bound on North Ardenwood Dr when he struck a pedestrian that was attempting to cross the roadway.

The driver attempted to flee the scene and was later apprehended by Uniformed Officers in a nearby parking lot.

At this time the pedestrian has not been identified and is expected to survive injuries sustained in the crash.

The driver was booked into East Baton Rouge Parish Prison for DWI, Reckless Operation of a Vehicle, Hit and Run, 1st Degree Vehicle Negligent Injuring and Expired Registration.
