## SHOOTING DEATH ON JOYCE DR

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating the shooting death of BRENDA MULLENS, 40, 2944 JOYCE DR that occurred last night around 10:28pm at the listed address. BRPD Detectives believe Mullens was shot by her ex-boyfriend, DAVYON BENTLEY, 24, 4009 NORTH 38<sup>TH</sup> ST during a verbal argument.

Mullens was transported to a local hospital where she succumbed to her injuries. Bentley fled the scene prior to police arrival.

Bentley was currently wanted by BRPD for Home Invasion, Illegal Use of a Weapon, Felon in Possession of a Firearm and Simple Criminal Damage to Property.

Detectives issued a warrant for Bentley's arrest in last night's shooting for 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder, Attempt 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder (3 counts), Illegal Use of a Weapon and Felon in Possession of a Firearm.

Davyon Bentley is considered armed and dangerous. Anyone with information on his whereabouts' is urged to contact the Violent Crime Unit at 389-4869 or Crime Stoppers at 344-7867.
